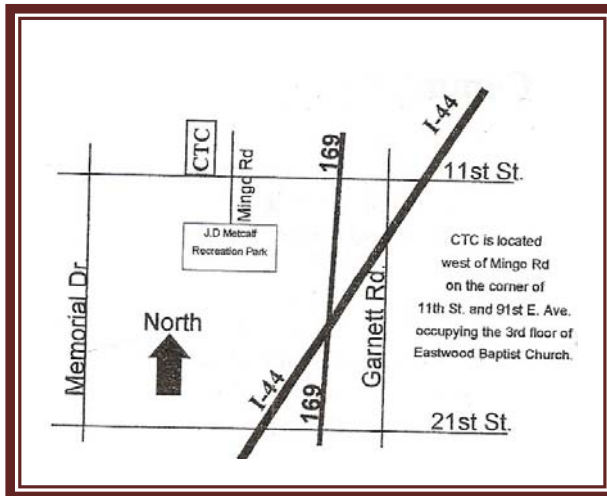

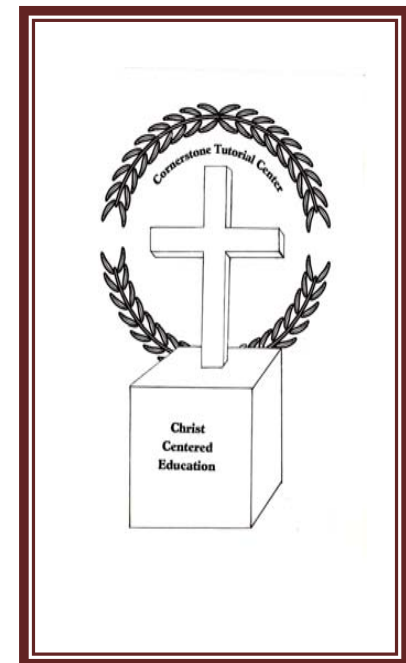
### **Classroom Space for Meetings:**

## Enrollment Process:

---

1. Complete and submit application to CTC. (All applications are subject to approval by the CTC board of directors.)
2. Family Interview: This is our opportunity to meet and talk with you and answer your questions about what we offer and how we can be of service to your family. This may also be your first opportunity to see our facility.
3. Orientation: Attend one of several orientations to meet tutors and discuss with them their classes, curriculum or teaching styles/expectations. This is also a time to learn more about CTC policies concerning financial obligations, conduct expectations, and how you can volunteer within our community.
4. Attend Registration and register for classes.
